



Educational and Motivational Assistance Tutor

Friends of Kids with Cancer is seeking a highly qualified educator for the Educational and Motivational Assistance Program (EdMAP). The successful candidate will have a strong, outgoing personality and experience building relationships with students in small group or one on one settings; have a passion for and understanding of the mission of Friends of Kids with Cancer; understand the balance between the learning needs of each student with the physical and emotional aspects of cancer treatment; be an advocate for students' needs at their school; have a strong understanding of educational needs and learning disabilities; develop relationships with key stakeholders at the pediatric oncology centers.

Some essential duties:

- Build relationships with patients and their families
- Visit our partner pediatric oncology centers multiple days a week
- Provide tutoring sessions through the Friends of Kids with Cancer offices
- Help students grow, develop and practice appropriate academic skills
- Include a focus on confidence and motivation for each student
- Advocate for educational needs with schoolteachers, counselors and administrators
- Participation in Friends of Kids with Cancer patient events is encouraged
- Strong emphasis on early elementary foundational skills

Minimum Candidate Requirements:

- Bachelor's Degree in Education
- Teaching Certificate
- Experience with elementary, middle or secondary school tutoring
- Strong knowledge of special education services
- Understanding of educational technology

This is a 1099 contracted position with flexibility based on hospital clinic hours and needs, outside of clinic one on one tutoring sessions in the Friends of Kids with Cancer office and naturally occurring seasonal educational need fluctuations. A minimum of 22 hours per week is guaranteed with a maximum billable allowance of 26 hours per week at a rate of \$25/hour.
