

SIDE PROJECT BREWING, RANKED THE SECOND BEST IN THE WORLD

If you have a love for craft beer, then you're going to love this article!

For beer drinkers around the world, Zwanze Day is a much anticipated yearly event. This day celebrates the release of Cantillon's Zwanze, a special release Lambic series established in 2008. Zwanze beer is usually a different style each year and is something other than a traditional Cantillon Lambic beer. Only a small batch of an experimental beer is brewed and an even smaller group of breweries around the world are offered a special keg to share with friends and customers. In conclusion... this beer is rare and exceptionally hard to get ahold of!

Nestled in the heart of Maplewood you will find one brewery that has beaten the odds and successfully acquired the sought after Zwanze brew for the past five years.





Side Project Brewing was founded by Cory and Karen King in 2014. What began as a dream and side project quickly became a booming establishment that beer enthusiasts have grown to love. Side Project focuses on producing only barrel-aged beers with an emphasis on Saisons, Wild Ales, and spirit barrel-aged beers. Passion experimentation drive the creation of these rustic to aggressive ales but what truly sets Side Project apart from their competitors is the love they have for the community in which they reside.

Despite the countless awards, world class nominations and esteemed press, Side Project has remained humble in their approach to giving back and lucky for us, Friends of Kids with Cancer has become one of their favorite charities to give back to.

KIDS HELPING KIDS

HARPER THE BRAVE & HER ONE OF A KIND DONATION

"On February 2nd, 2019, my youngest daughter, Harper, was diagnosed with leukemia. The next few days were hard. Two days later, while sitting in bed, Kelly from Child Services came in with a gift card from Friends of Kids with Cancer. Harper immediately perked up, and within 15 minutes she'd sent me out of the hospital to spend that money!! Friends of Kids with Cancer gave us our first good day. Harp is in remission and we wanted to give back some of what they've given us."- Matt, Harper's dad

Harper is a gamer; she's in Tales of the Margreve (Kobold Press) with her sister, Ghoul Island (Petersen Games), and she plays D&D and loves to write stories. It only made sense that she would help write a D&D adventure book and to use it as a platform to raise funds for Friends of Kids. This project began as a conversation in the hospital, turned into an outline after she was discharged, and is now an amazing book that we are all so proud of.

Harper's Tale, launched in September of 2019, is an epic D&D adventure story of





sacrifice, perseverance, and redemption. The heroes will investigate, battle, and learn the true origins of the threat to thei home- a mysterious illness that has taken over the town, leaving only two young women, Rose and Grace, to care for the populace. Harvesting the cure is their greatest challenge.

"Harper's Tale is much more than a story about hope and adventure. It's more than an opportunity to help kids just be kids. It's also about inclusivity and hearing the voices of those who aren't heard often enough." - Matt

It's a straightforward story but one with resonance to Harper going into remission. From seasoned writers and professional artists to individuals from the gaming community and crowdfunding backers, hundreds have rallied behind not only Harper for this project but all of the kids served by FOKWC.

When Harper and her family aren't gaming you can find them hosting countless other fundraisers for the Friend's Kids including









Bell Ringer: \$220/month


